

MME Testing 2009

All juniors and possibly 2 seniors will participate in the MME testing. There is no cost to the student to take the test. A student must participate in all three days of testing in order to receive MME scores and be eligible to receive the Michigan Promise Award of \$4000 (if it is not abolished by the Michigan legislature). If a student misses any part of the test, they must make up the entire thing. Make-up MME tests are scheduled for a time later in March.

March 10 Testing will occur at the LFA Hall in Amelith. See map on reverse side. Students should meet there by 7:50 am. If you need a ride to the LFA Hall from Valley, see Mr. Rogers by March 9th. He will arrange van transportation.

March 11 & 12 Testing will take place at Valley in pre-assigned classrooms.

Tuesday, March 10

8:00 am Testing begins at **LFA Hall** promptly at 8:00 am (even though it would normally be a late-start day). You will be taking an ACT test. It will result in a score that is reported to the colleges and universities of your choosing. The ACT includes tests in English, Reading, Math, Science, and Writing. There are two scheduled breaks during testing.

12:45 pm Testing ends at approximately this time. Students are excused from classes for the rest of the day. You will be allowed to participate in any extra-curricular practices or activities that take place after school.

Wednesday, March 11

8:00 am Testing will begin at Valley in pre-assigned classrooms promptly at 8:00 am. You will be taking the WorkKeys test (applied math, reading, and locating information). There is at least one scheduled break during this testing time. Students who meet minimum requirements on all three tests will be eligible to receive a certificate from the state.

10:45 am Testing ends at this time. Students will join the schedule in progress. The class hours will run in reverse on this day only so students will begin with 6th hour (during the normal time for 4th) followed by 5th, 4th, 3rd, 2nd, and end the day with 1st hour. SCC students are excused from the last 3 periods of the day.

Thursday, March 12

8:00 am Testing will begin at **Valley** promptly at 8:00 am. Students will be assigned to specific rooms to take the Michigan Math, Science and Social Studies tests. There is at least one scheduled break during this testing time.

10:30 am Testing ends at this time. Students will join the normal schedule for chapel (if they are finished testing) or will begin with their 4th hour. The schedule will progress in normal order.

What to bring: Pencils (several #2 pencils, and not the mechanical ones)
Calculator (we will not have enough to provide any at the LFA Hall)
Snack (you may bring pop, water, or juice and a snack but they will be placed in an area away from testing and only available during the breaks)

What not to bring: Reading or study material
Music, games, cards, etc.
