- Each period begins with a 5 or 10 minute organization time followed by 80 minutes of testing time.
- Students may come late if they only have a 2nd final or leave early if they only have a 1st final. However, we do expect them to attend chapel either way.
- If a student has a double final and cannot take it during the last period, they could take it immediately following the second final or on a later day.
- We will offer at least 1 study hall during each of the final exam periods (although for most periods there will likely be very few people).
- We will rotate through the cycles. For example: Year 1 will use First Cycle and then Second Cycle. Year 2 will use Third Cycle and then First Cycle. Year 3 will use Second Cycle and then Third Cycle.
- The two days before exams will be planned for review days and also used for some final exams not in the three-day schedule. Teachers should refrain from giving chapter/unit tests during this time.
