Qualifications

The ideal candidate will:

- Hold experience in athletic administration, coaching, or education
- possess strong organizational, leadership, technology, and communication skills

- Accept the school's statement of beliefs including those on marriage, gender and sexuality, and the sanctity of human life; and have a lifestyle that conforms to those beliefs

Responsibilities

- Provide overall leadership and vision for Valley Lutheran High School's athletic program in alignment with the school's mission and Lutheran identity
- Promote sportsmanship, teamwork, and Christian character among student athletes and coaches.
- Assist in the development of the athletic department budget and its management.
- Schedule, publicize, and provide appropriate management (including event preparation, supervision, admissions, game officials, transportation, security and all other game-day operations) for school athletic contests.

- Represent the school to Michigan High School Athletic Association and leagues in which the school holds membership. Oversee compliance with all related regulations.
- Employ (in partnership with school administration), supervise, and provide for the seasonal evaluation of coaches.
- Maintain accurate records, including eligibility, participation, and awards.
- Foster good relationships between the school's athletic department and members of the school community, Lutheran grade schools, and the broader community.
