Ministry Description for Media Recruitment

The purpose of the ministry of the Executive Director is to serve as a Christian role model for students and the community, provide long-range visionary Christ-centered educational leadership, maintain effective relationships with the community, constituents, parents, and donors, and provide financial and administrative oversight.

Qualifications

The ideal candidate will:

- have a personal commitment to Lutheran secondary education as a vital part of the ministry of the church.
- possess an earned master's degree with a major in educational administration.
- possess a minimum of 10 years experience in teaching and school administration.
- be eligible for a valid secondary school teaching certificate issued by the State of Michigan Department of Education.
- hold a Lutheran Teaching Diploma or its equivalent.
- possess excellent written, oral, and interpersonal communication skills.
- accept the school's statement of beliefs including those on marriage, sexuality and gender; and have a lifestyle that conforms to those beliefs.

Responsibilities

- Provide Christ-centered leadership for the Valley Lutheran High School Association.
- Work with the school leadership team, faculty and staff to provide educational and extra-curricular programs consistent with the School's core values. Implement and evaluate programs that keep the school moving forward.
- Work with the Board of Directors, school leadership team, faculty and other members of the school community to provide and implement a long and short term strategic plan for institutional academic, facility, funding and other ministry growth.

- Maintain effective relations with the students, parents, Pastors & Principals of Association churches, community, constituents, and donors in order to ensure the long-term support for the school's ministry. Effectively engage with the community in building relationships that strengthen Valley Lutheran. This includes the Lutheran community, the broader Christian community, the educational community, and the broader community in general.
- Provide financial oversight for the Association budget and long-range plans.
