Here is information that was shared with students on how the eLearning days will work:

1. We will have eLearning days every weekday from March 17 - 20 and March 23 - 27.
2. Students will need to check their VLHS email and Google Classroom for each of their courses every morning (after 8 am and before noon) to see what teachers have posted for them to do. Also, we will communicate some things through their Class of 20__ page.
3. Students are expected to complete assigned work and it will count towards 3rd quarter grades. More information is on our eLearning guidelines which will be on our website.
4. Students who were in school today were given some additional information on contacting teachers and what materials to take home. If your student was sick, please use the teachers' school emails for all communication for things related to their class.
5. Students who do not have regular access to a computer or laptop at home may check out a Chromebook from the school.
6. Students who do not have access to reliable internet should contact Dr. Meyers. There will be days and times where the computer lab at the school will be open for students to come in and collect their assignments. Students will be given space to work individually without being in a group. These days and times will be communicated next week through Remind, email, and on our website.
