Tuition Down Payment

New students make a non-refundable \$200 tuition down payment at the time of registration.

Re-Registration Fee

Returning students pay a \$100 re-registration fee. The fee is waived for students who complete re-registration **in full by April 1.**

Payment Schedules

Plan #1 - Annual

One lump sum payment

Plan #2 - Monthly Payment by Electronic Fund Transfer

Eleven equal payments beginning July 2019 through May 2020. Request and complete an Electronic Fund Transfer authorization form and return to the school office.

Plan #3 - Monthly Payment by Cash or Check

Eleven equal payments due on the 15th of each month beginning July 2019 through May 2020.

Plan #4 - Pre-Paid Tuition Payment Plan

To assist parents in their financial planning, families have the opportunity to pre-pay future tuition at the 2019-2020 tuition rate until July 31, 2019. No pre-payments will be accepted between August 1 and December 31. Tuition and Fee Payment Policies

Report cards, transcripts, and diplomas will be released only if tuition and fees are paid in full. The family is responsible for all costs resulting from referral of accounts to a collection agency or payments halted due to insufficient funds.

Students who withdraw during the school year will be charged tuition for the entire quarter in which they withdraw.

Financial Aid

Financial aid is available for students with a documented financial need. Applications need to be submitted to FACTS Grant & Aid for processing and evaluation. The link is on the VLHS website under 'Admissions', then 'Tuition and Financial Aid' tab. There is a \$30 processing fee. Applications must be submitted online by April 1, 2019 for full consideration.

Families will be informed of grants by June 30.
